- **Quaver Music** curriculum for the entire school.
- **Owl cameras (12)** were purchased. These are 360 degree cameras that are directly linked to zoom (APS videoing platform). They follow the teacher to optimize the virtual learning experience for our on-line learners and allows for more engaging teaching/learning.
- Writing and math kits for our younger learners in Kindergarten through 2<sup>nd</sup> grade.
