- a. **Discussion Item 1:** NAPPS Cluster data talk – Maggie provided update. NAPPS has requested MB to encourage parents to lean into NAPPS to have their voices heard to APS. Replacement for Jason Esteves being vetted (4 candidates).
- b. **Discussion Item 2:** Sutton / North Atlanta outreach – Clay talked about how we want to continue to build strong pipeline and encourage families to continue to APS. Kim mentioned rising 6th grade Sutton event at Mary Stuart Iverson’s house where Sutton leadership answered parents’ questions.

V. Information Items

a. **Principal’s Report :**

- i. Reviewed the CIP 45 Day Check-in progress against our three main goals (Improve Black/AA ELA scores, Improve Black/AA Math Scores, and Reduction of 3 of 6 grade levels of elevated BASC-3 BESS scores. All headed in right direction with first two measured by MAP improvement scores. Last one – CARE team is helping targeted individuals and for all SEL focus on students. CIP 45 Goals directly relate to Strategic Plan Priorities
- ii. Facilities update – painting still work in progress. Will need APS to send master facilities maintenance schedule
- iii. November MAP data:
 - 1. Reading/ELA: saw most improvement as WIN blocks have focused on this area. Saw growth with K-5 reading growth percentile quintile #2 district. Each grade level will be making adjustments as needed to WIN blocks.
 - 2. Math: not as much but comparable to other Top schools in district. Concern was raised of how we can also challenge / support our distinguished learners so their growth does not stagnate. More individualized math programs to be made available. Next year – APS rolling out new Math curriculum.
 - 3. Overall, for both ELA and Math saw all subgroups achieve above district average scores
