


WHAT IS MTSS?

MTSS (Multi-Tiered System of Supports) is a proactive, data-driven framework that provides academic, behavioral, and social-emotional support to all students based on their individual needs.

It's not a program—it's a way of organizing how we identify and respond to student needs early and effectively.



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

WHY MTSS MATTERS

- Early identification and support
- Reduces learning gaps
- Promotes equity and access for all students
- Encourages collaboration between teachers, families, and specialists
- Builds resilience and academic confidence



HOW DOES MTSS WORK?

MTSS uses three levels (tiers) of support:

- **Tier 1:** Core Support
 - High-quality instruction for all students
 - School-wide expectations
- **Tier 2:** Targeted Support
 - Small-group interventions for students who need extra help
 - Frequent progress monitoring
- **Tier 3:** Intensive Support
 - Individualized interventions
 - Support often involves specialists and higher intensity



HOW CAN FAMILIES GET INVOLVED?

Families are essential partners in MTSS!

Here's how you can support:

- Stay in regular contact with your child's teachers
- Attend parent-teacher or MTSS meetings
- Reinforce learning and behavior expectations at home
- Ask questions if your child is receiving additional support

Questions to Ask:

- What interventions are being used?
- How will progress be monitored?
- What can I do at home to help?
